Special Note Pertaining To Boundaries

These are older claims that have few signs and may or may not conform to the corners shown in table to the left. When the licensor took possession of these claims he was shown the following three spots by the previous owner that have been used to mark the boundaries. These three spots are marked on the map and are:
 Sign - Downieville sign East of town (39.55955N, 120.82395W - WGS84)
 Bridge (Hansen - up Main St.) - Gravel bar about 200 feet upstream.
 Walk - Turn on Nevada St., cross river, turn right on Durgan Flat Way, drive pass Court House and continue to end where there is a large parking lot with bathroom at end. Walk down the North Yuba Trail until you just get to the river (no mining sign on tree, posts each side of trail). This is the downstream (West) end of the claim.
