Directions From Reno

Take 395 North and turn West on Hwy 70. Drive to just West of Beckworth and turn North on Grizzly Rd. (Plumas 113). Stay on 113 driving around the East side of Lake Davis. You will stay on Plumas 113 taking any and all left turns towards Genesee until a short distance past mile marker 22 where you will turn to the left on to road 25N42. In a very short distance you will cross the creek with the claim on the left. Just past the creek you will come to a road going to the left that will take you in a short distance to good parking and camping on the claim.

Note:

The overall driving distance from Hwy 70 to the claim is just under 23 miles with the first 10 miles paved and the remaining distance a good dirt road suitable for 2 wheel drive vehicles.
