Got Access Issues on National Forest Managed Lands?

Step 1: Go on the internet and type: "Accomplishments | Public Lands For The People" download and print: "U.S.-v.-Hicks-mining-claimant-is-a-landowner.pdf"

Step 2: Download and print "16 U.S.C. 472" off the internet.

Step 3: Download and print "36 CFR 261.50(e)" off the internet.

[**Important:** make sure 36 CFR 261.50(e)(2) and (5) are on document]

Step 4: Print a copy of your assessment labor /or notice of location of your mining claim filed with the County showing proof of legal claimholder status. Mining Club claims will need to issue "Agent permission slips" from the legal owner of the Mining Claim in question.

Keep these documents in your vehicle with an extra copy for the forest service agent in case you are questioned. The Forest Service regulations do not require a NOI or POO for merely driving on an existing route. Knowledge is power. Tread lightly and Happy Prospecting!
